Accepted Recyclables:

- Newspapers, including inserts, coupons, & advertisements
- Junk Mail & Envelopes
- Mixed Paper (Office Paper, Paper Bags, Clean Cereal Boxes, Pasta Boxes, Egg Cartons, etc.)
- Cardboard (Please break down corrugated boxes flat)
- Magazines & Catalogs
- Paper Grocery Bags & Lunch Bags
- Empty Soda & Beer Cases
- Frozen Food Boxes
- Pizza Boxes (remove food)
- Paper Plates & Cups
- Gift, Toy, & Tissue Boxes
- Telephone Books
- Non-metallic Greeting Cards & Wrapping Paper
- Mailing Tubes
- Plastic Bottles w/ #1-7 symbol on bottom (Water Bottles, Soda Bottles, Detergent Bottles, Shampoo Containers, Milk Jugs, etc.)
- Plastic Food Trays (Microwave, Frozen Food, Candy, Cake, Cookie Trays, etc.)
- Hard Plastic (toys, buckets, etc.)
- Beverage/Food Bottles & Jars (Beer Bottles, Liquor Bottles, Salsa Jars, Jelly Jars, etc.)
- Gable Top Containers (Milk & Juice Cartons, etc.)
- Aseptic Containers (Drink Boxes, Soy Milk Containers, Soup Boxes)
- All Food & Beverage Cans (Tin, Aluminum, etc.) – Place lids inside cans
- Aluminum Foil
- Aluminum Baking Tins

FOR ALL PLASTIC, GLASS, GABLE TOP, & METAL CONTAINERS – PLEASE RINSE THOROUGHLY. LABELS DO NOT NEED TO BE REMOVED.

PLEASE KEEP RECYCLABLES SEPARATE FROM OTHER TRASHED ITEMS.

Battery Recycling:

- Nickel Cadmium (Ni-cad) (typically found in cordless power tools, cell phones, laptops, camcorders)
- Nickel Metal Hydride (Ni-MH)
- Lithium Ion (typically found in small electronic devices, laptops)
- Button Cells (typically found in small electronic devices)
- Lead Acid (Power Supplies (UPS))
- Alkaline Batteries (AA, AAA, C, & D) do not need to be recycled and can be disposed of with your regular household trash.

CAR BATTERIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. THEY CAN BE RETURNED TO ANY LOCATION THAT SELLS THEM REGARDLESS OF WHETHER YOU BOUGHT IT THERE OR NOT.

PLEASE HAVE BATTERIES WRAPPED INDIVIDUALLY AND KEPT SEPARATE FROM ALL OTHER RECYCLABLES AND TRASH.
