§ 261-1. Use regulations.

No person or corporation or firm shall use any of the potable waters of said Village or draw the same from the pipe lines of said Village for domestic or other uses whatsoever, without the consent and authority of the Board of Trustees of said Village, under a penalty as set forth in § 261-3 of this chapter for each and every offense, in addition to the value of any such use at the scheduled price therefor adopted by the Board of Trustees.

§ 261-2. Unlawful waste of water.

Any person or persons, using the Village water, who permit the same to run to waste, upon being and notified to repair such leakage, within 24 hours, and failing or neglecting to do so within the time specified, shall be cut off from all use of such water, and the water shall not be turned on again without the payment of a fee as set from time to time by resolution of the Board of Trustees for the benefit of the Village.

§ 261-3. Penalties for offenses.

Any person who shall violate any provision of this chapter shall be punishable, upon conviction, by a fine not exceeding \$250 or a term of imprisonment not exceeding 15 days, or both, for each violation.
