§ 98-1. Riding on sidewalks prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons within the corporate limits of the Village of St. Johnsville, New York, to ride any vehicle commonly known as a "wheel" or "bicycle" upon any of the sidewalks of the Village of St. Johnsville, except crossing crosswalks in streets.

§ 98-2. Penalties for offenses. 1

Each violation of this chapter shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$250, or by imprisonment for not more than 15 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
