§ 193-1. Damage to property; obstructions; removal of lawful notices.

It shall be unlawful for any person within the Village of St. Johnsville, New York, to willfully or maliciously break, mar, injure, remove, or deface any building, fence, awning, sign, tree, shrubbery, or other property, public or private, in said Village, or pile up before any door or on any street any boxes, casks, or other substance or material or to tear down any notice, handbill, or legal notice lawfully posted.

§ 193-2. Unauthorized use of property.

It shall be unlawful for any person within the Village of St. Johnsville, New York, to take or use or to exert control over for the purpose of converting to his own use any of the property of the Village of St. Johnsville without first obtaining the consent of the Mayor and Board of Trustees.

§ 193-3. Penalties for offenses. ¹

Any person violating this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of not more than \$250 or imprisonment for not more than 15 days, or both such fine and imprisonment.
