§ 56-1. Seal established.

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of St. Johnsville 8-6-1906 as Ordinance 1 of the 1906 Bylaws, Rules and Ordinances; amended in its entirety at time of adoption of Code (see Ch. 1, General Provisions, Art. D). Subsequent amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 56-1. Seal established.

It being acknowledged that incorporation of the Village of St. Johnsville in 1857 was benefited by the availability of local agriculture, industry, and transportation, a common Corporate Seal is hereby established to memorialize these significant historical facts.

§ 56-2. Design.

- A. The Seal shall be circular and reflect a designated circular center portion divided into upper and lower halves with the remaining internal area depicted as a surrounding ring.
- B. The upper half of the center circle shall be divided into equal left and right parts with the left part displaying a centered plowshare and the right part displaying a centered water wheel. The entire lower half of the center circle shall display a centered locomotive and tender.
- C. The upper half of the surrounding ring shall bear the inscription "Village of St. Johnsville 1857" and be spread so as to cover its entire circumference. The lower half of the surrounding ring shall bear the inscription "Corporate Seal" centered under the locomotive and tender.
