§ 103-1. Conduct authorized.

It shall be lawful for any authorized organization, as defined in § 476 of the General Municipal Law, upon obtaining the required license, to conduct the game of bingo within the territorial limits of the Village of St. Johnsville, subject to the provisions of this chapter, Article 14-H of the General Municipal Law and Article 19-B of the Executive Law.

§ 103-2. Sunday games.

Any game of bingo conducted within the Village pursuant to a license issued in accordance with this chapter and the applicable statutes may be operated by authorized organizations on the first day of the week, commonly known as "Sunday."

§ 103-3. Delegation of authority.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of St. Johnsville hereby delegates its authority under this chapter in relation to the issuance and receipt of application, the issuance of licenses and the collection and transmission of fees, to the Village Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of St. Johnsville, New York, and delegates the authority granted to it in relation to the conduct of investigations and the supervision of the operation of games of chance, to the Chief of Police of the Village of St. Johnsville, New York.

§ 103-4. When effective.

The provisions of Article 14-H of the General Municipal Law and this chapter shall be effective immediately in the Village of St. Johnsville pursuant to a proposition therefor submitted at the election held in the Village of St. Johnsville on March 18, 1958, which was approved by a vote of the majority of the qualified electors in the Village of St. Johnsville voting thereon.
