A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING RESIDENCY ELIGIBILITY FOR VARIOUS APPOINTED PUBLIC OFFICES IN THE VILLAGE OF ST. JOHNSVILLE

6.1 Findings.

The duly incorporated Village of St. Johnsville, situated wholly in the County of Montgomery, has continually maintained a population of less than three thousand (3000) residents rendering it difficult to rely on interested and qualified citizens to seek any of the various appointed local public offices.

Village Law 3-300(2), and other applicable law, grants a Board of Trustees the authority to provide that appointed village officers may reside within the County in which the village is wholly or partially situated.

6.2. Appointed Offices.

The appointed local public offices in the Village of St. Johnsville, individually and as are now, or may hereafter be, established or consolidated, are determined to be: Clerk, Treasurer, Deputy Clerk, Deputy Treasurer, Assessor, Superintendent of Public Works, Code Enforcement Officer, Acting Village Justice, Planning Board members and Zoning Board of Appeals members.

6.3. Procedure.

Upon the effective date of this local law it shall be permissible in the Village of St. Johnsville for any person who is a resident of the County of Montgomery, and who is otherwise duly eligible under applicable law, to be appointed to a public office designated herein.

6.4. Repeal of Prior Enactments.

All prior enactments of the Board of Trustees, either consistent or inconsistent with this legislation, are hereby repealed and deemed to be of no force or effect.

6.5. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State.
