**ARTICLE I**  
**Collection**

**[Adopted 6-23-1977; ratified and amended at time of adoption of Code (see Ch. 1, General Provisions, Art. I)]**

**§ 221-1. Definitions.**

As used in this article, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

**BULKY WASTES** — Large items, such as furniture, appliances and water heaters.

**FOOD WASTES** — Animal, vegetable or mineral matter derived from the preparation or packaging of foodstuffs.

**RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTES** — Putrescibles, rubbish, trash, etc., resulting from the normal activity of households.

**RUBBISH AND TRASH** — Combustibles such as paper, wood, yard trimmings, etc., and noncombustibles such as metal, glass, stone, dirt, etc.

**§ 221-2. Service schedule.**

All residential solid wastes (including rubbish and trash) will be collected as set forth from time to time by resolution of the Board of Trustees.

**§ 221-3. Hours.**

- A. Collection shall be made during the hours as set from time to time by resolution of the Board of Trustees.
- B. It will be the residents' responsibility to see that wastes are placed in the proper location before the designated pickup time.

**§ 221-4. Approved containers.**

- A. All wastes shall be placed in plastic or metal garbage pails of up to 30 gallons in capacity. Plastic trash bags are also acceptable.
- B. Containers are not to exceed 60 pounds each.

**§ 221-5. Bundles.**

Materials containing only yard trimmings and rubbish may be placed for collection in a securely tied bundle not to exceed four feet in length and 60 pounds in weight apiece.

**§ 221-6. Unapproved containers.**

The contractor shall not be required to collect solid wastes unless they are in approved containers or bundles.

**§ 221-7. Location for pickup.**

All wastes shall be placed curbside prior to commencement of collection.

**§ 221-8. Bulky wastes.**

All wastes which exceed 60 pounds but are less than 300 pounds will be collected as set from time to time by resolution of the Board of Trustees.

**§ 221-9. Enforcement.**

The provisions of this article will be strictly enforced and there will be no exceptions.

**§ 221-10. Penalties for offenses.**

Any person who shall violate any provision of this article shall be punishable, upon conviction, by a fine not exceeding \$250 or a term of imprisonment not exceeding 15 days, or both, for each violation.
