LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 2019

A LOCAL LAW TO INCREASE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS

- I. FINDINGS. Article XI, Section 275-33, of the Zoning Law, originally adopted in 1962, established, and has continually authorized, a three (3) member Board of Appeals. The zoning issues arising since 1962 have become increasingly complex causing the realization that Board of Appeals deliberations would be best served by a greater number of members in order to provide both an equitable sharing of work load and a more diverse input to issue resolution. Village Law 7-712(2) authorizes a Zoning Board of Appeals with a maximum of five (5) members.
- II. MEMBERSHIP. Section 275-33 of the Village of St. Johnsville Zoning Law is hereby amended to increase the membership of the Board of Appeals from three (3) to five (5) members.
- III. EFFECT. This local law shall take effect upon its filing with the Secretary of State.
