LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 2017

A Local Law Changing the Residency Requirements and Authorizing the Change of Designations Regarding the St. Johnsville Offices of Village Clerk, Village Treasurer and Village Clerk-Treasurer.

- I. FINDINGS. The St. Johnsville Board of Trustees finds that the Village, situated wholly within the County of Montgomery, should be prepared for the possibility that qualified village residents may not always be available for appointment to the crucial offices of Village Clerk and Village Treasurer. The Board of Trustees finds further, upon consideration of increasing work load burdens being placed upon Village Clerks and Village Treasurers generally, that continuing the present consolidation of the local offices of Village Clerk and Village Treasurer may not be conducive to more efficient governmental operations.
- II. RESIDENCY. Pursuant to the authority of Village Law 3-300(2)(a), and commencing effective from April 3, 2017, legal residents of the County of Montgomery shall be eligible for appointment to the St. Johnsville offices of Village Clerk, Village Treasurer, or Village Clerk-Treasurer so long as the Board of Trustees determines that this consolidated office shall continue.
- III. DESIGNATION OF OFFICE. The presently consolidated office of St. Johnsville Village Clerk-Treasurer shall continue until such time that this Board of Trustees, by resolution pursuant to the authority of Village Law 3-301(2)(b) and in accordance with other applicable law, determines otherwise.
- IV. EFFECT. This local law shall take effect upon its filing with the Secretary of State.
