

RESOLUTION NO. 8 OF 2026

RESOLUTION TO ADJUST WATER AND SEWER RENTS

Motion by ^{Mayor} ~~Trustee~~ Steven Elwood Seconded by Trustee Thomas Steele

WHEREAS, this Board of Trustee has determined pursuant to the authority of Village law 11-1118 and 11-1120, and the General Municipal Law Article 14-F 'Sewer Rent Law', that continually rising costs justify and require that water and sewer rents for both village and contractual outside-of-village users must be adjusted in order to continually maintain necessary and satisfactory services for the consuming public,

NOW, THEREFORE, this 29th day of April, 2026 be it

RESOLVED, metered and non-metered billing periods shall be adjusted to 4-month cycles, with bills coming out every June, October, and February, and continuing thereafter, or until further determination of this Board; and,

RESOLVED, for the metered and non-metered billing period from February 3, 2026 to June 8, 2026, water rents for village *residential* users shall be \$0.14 per cubic foot and sewer rents shall be \$0.10 per cubic foot; and, water rents for outside-of-village *residential* users shall be \$0.14 per cubic foot; and, sewer rents for sewer-only *residential* users shall be a flat fee of \$168.75; and,

RESOLVED, commencing with the June 8, 2026 to October 5, 2026 metered and non-metered billing period, and continuing thereafter, or until further determination of this Board, water rents for village *residential* users shall be \$0.09 per cubic foot and sewer rents shall be \$0.10 per cubic foot; and, water rents for outside-of-village *residential* users shall be \$0.09 per cubic foot; and, sewer rents for sewer-only *residential* users shall be a flat fee of \$168.75; and,

RESOLVED, that all *residential* users shall be subject to a minimum fee at the above mentioned rates for usages between 0 – 1,667 cubic feet per billing period, or 5,000 cubic feet annually, and continuing thereafter, or until further determination of this Board; and,

RESOLVED, commencing with the May 11, 2026 to June 8, 2026 metered and non-metered billing period, and continuing thereafter, or until further determination of this Board, water rents and sewer rents for village *commercial*

users, and water rents for outside-of-village *commercial* users, shall be tiered and the rates as described herein; and,

Commercial Sewer (3,335 – 13,335)	\$0.15 per cubic foot
Commercial Sewer (13,336 – 33,336)	\$0.145 per cubic foot
Commercial Sewer (33,337 – 999,999)	\$0.13 per cubic foot
Commercial Outside-of-Village Water (0 – 3,334)	\$0.13 per cubic foot
Commercial Outside-of-Village Water (3,335 – 13,335)	\$0.12 per cubic foot
Commercial Outside-of-Village Water (13,336 – 33,336)	\$0.115 per cubic foot
Commercial Outside-of-Village Water (33,337 – 999,999)	\$0.10 per cubic foot

RESOLVED, commencing with the May 11, 2026 to June 8, 2026 metered and non-metered billing period, and continuing thereafter, or until further determination of this Board, water rents and sewer rents for village *mixed-use* users shall be tiered and the rates as described herein; and,

Mixed-Use Water (0 – 3,334)	\$0.12 per cubic foot
Mixed-Use Water (3,335 – 13,335)	\$0.11 per cubic foot
Mixed-Use Water (13,336 – 33,336)	\$0.105 per cubic foot
Mixed-Use Water (33,337 – 999,999)	\$0.09 per cubic foot
Mixed-Use Sewer (0 – 3,334)	\$0.15 per cubic foot
Mixed-Use Sewer (3,335 – 13,335)	\$0.14 per cubic foot
Mixed-Use Sewer (13,336 – 33,336)	\$0.135 per cubic foot
Mixed-Use Sewer (33,337 – 999,999)	\$0.12 per cubic foot

RESOLVED, that no public hearing is required for the within actions because penalties for non-payment of any of the above-described rents shall be the same as historically adopted and continued by village Boards of Trustees, and, sewer rents have been previously established and imposed and are herein only being adjusted; and,

RESOLVED, whenever unpaid water and sewer rents are included in the annual village tax levy, the water and sewer funds shall be credited with the amount of unpaid rents, including penalties, and the amounts so levied, when collected, shall be paid into the general fund.
